2010 WATER SPRINKLING SCHEDULE

Ho-Ho-Kus continues to maintain an excellent supply of water, exceeding federal and state standards in quality.

This year all residents must strive to conserve water.

In the event that a "No Sprinkling" water emergency is declared, then outside sprinkling is prohibited until further notice.

Last year there were many residents who were watering on the wrong days.

Over-usage by the borough may result in fines of up to \$50,000. The

Department of Environmental Protection can levy fines of up to \$5000 per day for as long as they deem the over-usage is not being properly addressed.

NO WATERING IS PERMITTED ON MONDAYS! NO WATERING AFTER MIDNIGHT SUNDAY. THIS RESTRICTION IS FOR THE ENTIRE BOROUGH.

AREA 1– residents south of Hollywood Avenue and west of East Saddle River Road on TUESDAYS, THURSDAYS AND SATURDAYS.

Area-2 – residents north of Hollywood Avenue and all those east of East Saddle River Road on WEDNESDAYS, FRIDAYS AND SUNDAYS.
