**WHEREAS**, there currently exists a need to appoint a new police officer in the Ho-Ho-Kus Police Department in order to ensure proper police coverage for the safety and welfare of the Borough, especially since there will be two or three retirements later this year; and

**WHEREAS**, applicants for appointment are required to take and pass a physical examination and to meet the personnel qualifications set forth in Code Sections 46-7 and 46-8; and

**WHEREAS**, such appointments are subject to successful completion of training at the Bergen County Law and Public Safety Institute, classes of which will begin in July 2013,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ho-Ho-Kus that interviews commence as quickly as possible so that the successful candidate, to be determined following such interviews, may be appointed in a timely manner enabling that candidate to attend classes at the Police Academy in July.
