**Nov 1<sup>st</sup> – Many things change**

- **Trash pick-up begins only once a week** – to your second week day Thursday or Friday schedule. This we remain in effect until April 1<sup>st</sup>.
- **Leaf pick up begins** - check the website or your calendar for your dates or call Borough Hall if you are not certain. Please keep the roads clear of parked cars on you pick up dates.

**2016 A new state law requires all Fire Hydrants to be cleared.**

Please note the residents with fire hydrants on their property are now required to remove snow within 24 hours, the same as sidewalks.

**Signs will be removed if found to be in violation.**

- Borough Ordinance prohibits signs in the Borough Right of Way- usually the first 10 feet of your yards from the end of the road.
- All real estate for sale signs must have a permit. Stop by Borough Hall to obtain one, the cost is \$50.

This free service is for residents only, and we reserve the right to limit you to 3 boxes if demand dictates. **Project medicine drop box-**

The Ho-Ho-Kus Police along with The Mayor & Council are proud to support the Attorney General's program to get **prescription painkillers** off the street, and provide a safe way to dispose of **any unwanted or expired pills (no liquids) confidentially**. The Drop Box is located in Police Headquarters 55 Sycamore Ave. and is available 24/7/365. Please consider using this for all your **non liquid meds** to not only stop opiate abuse, but help the environment and protect our water supply, that improper disposal or flushing creates.
