

**BOROUGH OF HO-HO-KUS
ORDINANCE # 1043**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 25 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF
HO-HO-KUS ENTITLED "FIRE DEPARTMENT"**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ho-Ho-Kus, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that Chapter 25 of the Code is hereby amended as follows:

I. **SECTION 25-10 Junior Firefighters Auxiliary** is amended to read:

“There is hereby established as part of the Fire Department of the Borough, a Junior Firefighters Auxiliary in accordance with all the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:14-95 through 40A:14-98 inclusive and the qualifications for membership in the Auxiliary shall be as follows:

- A. Any person between the ages of sixteen (16) and twenty-one (21) being a resident of the Borough in good standing and of good moral character or a child of any senior member shall be eligible for membership in the Junior Firefighters Auxiliary.
- B. No change.

Section 25-11 Severability

If any portion of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by the Court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance, but shall be confined in its effect to the provision directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

Section 25-12: Repealer

All other ordinances of the Borough, or parts thereof, which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 25-13: Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
