- 68 Brandywine Rd. – Residents are asking to have a purple Plum tree in the ROW removed.

- 841 Bernard Place – Residents would like to have a stump removed and have soil and seeds added to their front yard.
- 1 Lloyd Rd: Tree removed by DPW. **File Closed.**
- NEW BUSINESS: / PERMITS:
- 255 Ackerman Ave. – Residents filed a permit asking to remove one Shade Tree for completion of their project.
- 1 Brookview Ct. Resident asked for tree to be inspected for removal. Commissioner Chase inspected the property and reported that the tree in question is not ST. – **File Closed.**
- 6 Brownstone Way: Commissioner Chase conducted an inspection in August and 6 trees for removal will be added to 2018 Fall removal list.
- 67 Carlton Ave. Residents are concerned about the safety of one tree and would like to have the tree removed and a new one planted.
- 11 Chestnut Place: Residents would like two trees trimmed. One tree is over the driveway and another close to wires.
- 15 Chestnut Place :Residents would like inspection of tree roots damaging their driveway.
- 8 Clearwater Dr. : Resident planted 36 Alberta Spruces in the ROW.
